The title of the paper should be followed by Name, Designation, and Contact number, Name of the Organization / University/Institution and E-mail address of authors. Abstracts (maximum 500 words) should be submitted by **28th December 2016** and **full papers** on MS Word format, the body of the paper shall be in Times New Roman, font size 12, 1.5 line spacing, foot notes should

be in Times New Roman, size 10 single line spacing (approximately 10-12 pages/ 5,000 words). All references must be in form of foot-notes with font size 10 and should be according to the Bluebook 19th Edition to the organizers on or before **4th January 2017**. The papers should be submitted along with the following informations: (1) Full name of the author (2) Contact details of the author. The authors of the accepted papers will be duly intimated. The organizers will have the authority to change the schedule of programme and change if any, in the programme schedule shall be communicated accordingly.
